




Using Blackboard's LinkMaker program with *Oxford English Dictionary*



1. Within the area you wish to add links, make sure that Edit Mode is turned 'ON' in the upper, right-hand corner.



2. From the "Add Interactive Tool" menu, select "Library Electronic Resource LinkMaker".



3. Click on the "Databases" button.
