


Using BlackBoard's LinkMaker program with *Sage Journals Online*



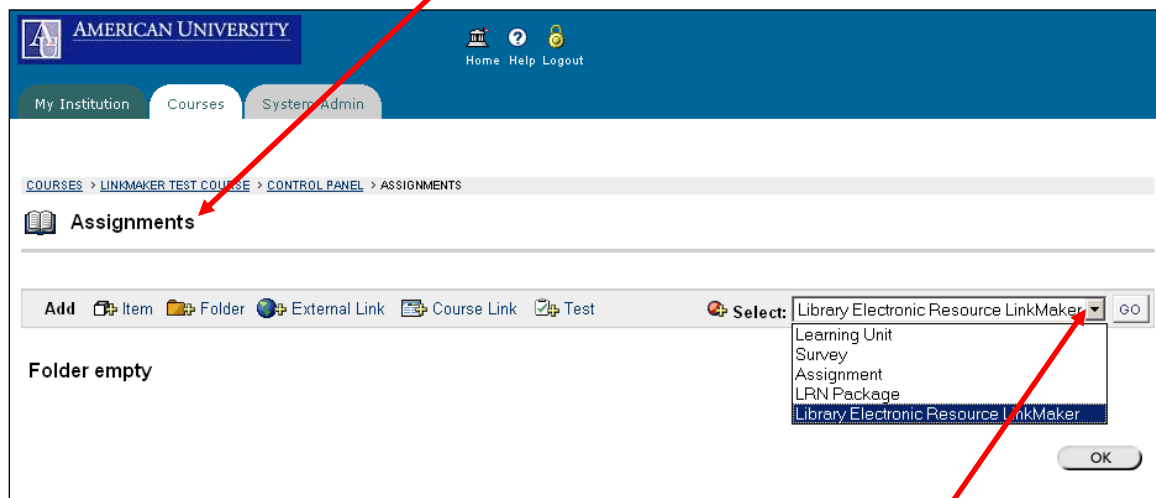
