


Using Blackboard's LinkMaker program with *Television News Archive*




1. Within the area you wish to add links, make sure that Edit Mode is turned 'ON' in the upper, right-hand corner.



There are no transcripts or captioning provided.

The complete London Times newspaper starting in 1785 and ending in 1999. The publication separates from the London Times.

(Studio: Garrick Utley) Apparent scope of **Chernobyl** nuclear power plant accident in USSR near Kiev, reported

(DC: Robert Hager) Factors indicating possible high death toll and Sweden's initial detection of radioactive fallout reviewed; scenes shown. [Voice of Radio MOSCOW - announces accident.] [Union of Concerned Scientists spokesperson Dr. James MacKENZIE - explains basis of his concern over magnitude of accident.] [National Resources Defense Council spokesperson Thomas COCHRAN - believes accident was full-scale meltdown of reactor.] Reactor meltdown explained; Three Mile Island 1979 accident recalled. [Georgetown Univ. spokesperson Dr. Thane GUSTAFSON - explains Soviet design of nuclear reactors.] Possible major nuclear accident 29 years ago in Urat Mts. recalled.
